

HUNTING ON TRIBAL LANDS

The Nine tribes that share South Dakota's borders offer spectacular hunting opportunities. To hunt on tribal lands, you will need to contact the tribal game, fish, and parks office of the tribe whose land you wish to hunt to obtain a hunting license.

You will need to be aware of the rules and regulations of the tribe where you will be hunting. Each tribe has their own hunting regulations. This includes knowing if a hunting guide is required to hunt on a particular reservation where hunting is allowed, the application deadlines for big game, and other hunting related concerns.

Tribal hunting licenses are not interchangeable with the state of South Dakota hunting licenses or with the hunting licenses of other tribes. The tribes do not sell state hunting licenses.

With proper planning you can have a successful and unique hunting experience on tribal lands. This guide will direct you to the game fish and parks offices of the tribes that share South Dakota's borders.
